**Driving Instructions:** Salina sets conveniently at the crossroads of Interstate 70 and Interstate 135 (the two major highways in Kansas). There are highway signs along both to assist you to the Bicentennial Center.

**From I-70:** Exit I-70 at the Ohio Street exit. Proceed south approximately 2¾ miles until Iron Avenue. Make a right turn (West) onto Iron Avenue and go approximately ½ mile to Oakdale Avenue and turn left (South). Continue south until you reach the Bicentennial Center located adjacent to Kenwood park.

**From I-135:** Exit from I-135 at the Crawford Street exit. Go East approximately 2½ miles to Ohio Street. Turn left (North) on Ohio Street and go ¾ mile to a street named The Midway. Turn left on The Midway (West) and it will lead you directly to the Bicentennial Center.
