

**Soil reclamation is achieved with continuous no-till.** This process consists of four phases listed below. It is our experience that the producer's education is similar to this process.

- Phase 1 *Initialization (0-5 years)*
- Phase 2 *Transition (6-10 years)*
- Phase 3 *Consolidation (11-20 years)*
- Phase 4 *Maintenance (+20 years)*
